

Delegates Must be 15 years of age by January 1st 2016

- **Registration:** 6:00-7:30pm, Friday March 4th 2016 The camp will not be responsible for delegates dropped off before 6:00pm. SNO FEST will end at approximately 12:15pm. on Sunday to allow time for travel.
